Attention Parents! Please read the following instructions carefully.

### REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

The following instructions explain how to enroll your child in the Winter 2012 Session of the After School Discovery Program. **Registration forms are found on the last pages of the program booklet and additional forms can be found in the school office or on the PTO Web site "<http://www.wickliffepto.org>"**

**Please use only one registration form for each class.** More than one student may be registered on the same form for the same class. This really helps us to make sure everyone is on the correct roster.

**Drop-off & Mail-in Registration:** Completed registration forms and class fees may be mailed to the address at the bottom of the registration form. Mail-in registration must be received no later than **Wednesday, January 18th, 2012 (Wednesday January 11<sup>th</sup> for "DIG-IN" class.** You may also **drop off your registration to the ASD box in the school office** by end of the school day (2:50PM) or send into school with your child to turn it in to the office themselves.

**A SEPARATE REGISTRATION AND CHECK must be completed for each class.** NO CASH, PLEASE!! Please make checks payable to Wickliffe PTO.

**You will not receive any confirmation form.** Your child is enrolled if they are on the roster (unless otherwise notified –eg the class was cancelled). Rosters for classes will be emailed by **Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012** and posted in the hallway outside the school office Monday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 before classes begin, if you or your child would like to check then, and we will send an email roster by the same day if you provided an email address.

The Winter session includes interruptions due to holidays, school activities and school closings. All course dates are listed in this booklet. Check course descriptions for this important information to note in your calendar.

In the event that a class is overfilled at the close of registration, the After School Discovery program will make every attempt to add another class. Participants will be notified of additional class time choices if available. If classes remain overfilled after these efforts, class participants will be selected through a lottery.

If there is insufficient enrollment for a class, it will be canceled and your check will be voided and will either be destroyed or returned to you.

**No refunds** after registration, except in the case of lottery or insufficient enrollment.

Telephone and Walk-In registration cannot be accepted, (but call Richard at 614 488 3688 anyway).

### SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURES

Partial Scholarships will be made available to those who have financial need. Scholarships are provided for on-site classes only. This offer is limited to one course per child. You can obtain a scholarship application from Sheila Millard in the school office. All requests will be kept strictly confidential.

**POLICIES FOR ASD CLASSES HELD AT WICKLIFFE**

**Class Arrival Policy:** For those classes held at Wickliffe: At the end of the school day (2:50 p.m.) students should proceed directly to the classroom where their After School Discovery class is being held. Children should wait in the hall until the instructor or parent volunteer arrives.

**Attendance Policy:** At the beginning of each class, instructors and/or parent volunteers will take attendance to ensure that each student is accounted for. If your child is in SACC, tell them about your child's ASD class.

**Class Dismissal Policy:** Parents/guardians are to pick students up **IN THE CLASSROOM**. Students will NOT be released on their own. Any students not being picked up after 10 minutes following the end of class time will be taken to the school office and parents will be called at that time. Instructor/parent volunteers will escort SACC students to the gym following class.

**Discipline Policy:** All students participating in Wickliffe's After School Discovery Program are expected to follow Upper Arlington's "Pillars of Ethical Behavior", showing courtesy and respect for both fellow students and instructors. Upon the second warning for inappropriate behavior, a student will be sent to the office for the remainder of the class and will not be permitted to return to future classes. Parents will be notified. Class fees will not be refunded under these circumstances.

**PARENT VOLUNTEERS**

Upon instructor request, we are in need of parent volunteers for certain in-house classes. These parents help with things like attendance, assisting the instructor with class, and help with dismissal after class has ended. If you can to help in this capacity for a class in which your child is enrolled, please indicate such on the Registration Form. An ASD co-chair will contact you to confirm your involvement. Thank you.

**REQUESTED PROCEDURES FOR CLASSES HELD OFF-SITE**

Transportation for off-site classes will be provided by the parent/guardian. Instructors request that students arrive promptly for class and that parents are also prompt in picking up students after class has ended. Supervision will not be provided for students except for specified class time. Some classes will require waivers.

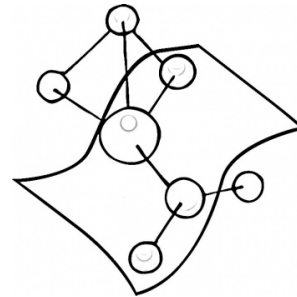
### KIDS ON THE COURT

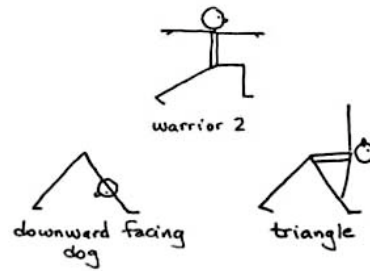
### SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING FUN

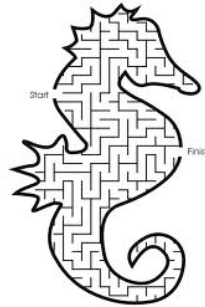
